

Environmental policy

Aware of its environmental and social responsibilities, Nordic Kraft is committed to continually improve the environmental performance of the activities under its responsibility in a context of sustainable development.

The corporative guidelines for implementing this policy are as follows:

- > Comply with all regulatory requirements applicable to its environmental aspects.
- Measure its greenhouse gas emissions and monitor its environmental discharge (water, air, waste) to assess its impact on the environment.
- > Partner with major raw material suppliers and subcontractors who comply with environmental regulatory requirements.
- > Use resources in a sustainable way.
- > Train employees and subcontractors to their role as individuals, on the impacts of their activities on the environment.
- > Set targets and objectives for environmental aspects and monitor them in a continuous improvement approach.
- > Conduct regular environmental compliance audits to verify that management and operating practices comply with regulatory requirements.
- > Identify and evaluate potential risks to the environment and take action to prevent, control or eliminate these risks.
- Communicate this policy to its employees, suppliers and subcontractors and make it available to the public.
